### Federal Programs

- Preschool and Kindergarten screening is almost complete. We will continue to take appointments for as long as necessary.
- Planning and needs assessments for next year will be taking place in May and June.
- We have had 14 referrals for special education services. 9 students have qualified for services, 4 was not eligible and 1 the parent did not complete the referral paperwork.
- We currently have 76 students with IEP's enrolled in the district preschool through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. We are serving 6 students through Speech Intervening Services.
- MAP-A testing will be window has been extended until May 21<sup>st</sup>.

### Curriculum

- Non-core teachers that were new last year are finishing up their curriculum. Those will continue to be approved as they are completed.
