-Quarantined two grade levels for 14 days

- Students are continuing their education through virtual learning during this time. Teachers are providing instruction through different platforms such as Google Classroom and Zoom (to meet small group needs and to meet students at their learning level). Both grade levels have continued to deliver new content in Reading, Math, Science and Social Studies to continue the students education. When Science or Social Studies can be integrated into Reading as nonfiction text, that is being done, to ease the work load. Title teachers in both math and reading are working to meet with students, to continue to work on the skills that students are struggling with, to help close the gap which has grown during the COVID shut down.

Information with expectations outlined for students, teachers, and parents as well as a schedule was sent to parents through the class facebook page. Teachers also attempted to contact all families by phone and go over the plan prior to the first day of virtual learning.

- Fourth grade students are expected to work on whole group work and independent work for approximately 3-3 1/2 hours depending on the student's working speed. Students were also given the expectation of working with Title if they were in Title groups and to work on enrichment type apps/programs like iReady.
