Current Seasons

- Our varsity boys team won the Tri-Rivers Classic tournament with a 49-37 victory over Clark County. North Shelby defeated our girls by 6 points in the consolation championship.
- Our JH programs completed five days of competition in the past week. They complete their seasons this week.

COVID

- Both girls and boys high school teams have been quarantined over the past couple of weeks due to a single positive test on each team.
- Current CDC guidelines allow individuals to "test out" of quarantine on day 7 (or later) of their quarantine. Those who do not test will have to complete the 10 days of quarantine from last known contact with the positive case.
- "Close contact" by MSHSAA definition includes being within 6 feet for 15 minutes or more, physical contact, or exchanging air droplets.
- We are taking the more conservative route by quarantining when we cannot eliminate (with a reasonable degree of certainty) the possibility of close contact. Some schools may choose to not quarantine if they can't prove close contact. These are polar opposites in philosophical approach and will result in different outcomes when evaluating the effectiveness of quarantines.
- Choosing not to contact trace holds the highest risk. Infected players, symptomatic or not, may continue to spread the virus for up to 10 days. The virus doesn't stay only in the ranks of healthy, young athletes.
- Current policy allows for two tickets for each player, cheerleader, manager, and coach for home contests. Visiting teams will receive one for each. We request they don't bring cheerleaders.
