RE: Administrator's Report

Federal Programs

- Spring testing for MAP-A begins again in February.
- All Special Education files for monitoring have been submitted to DESE.
- Desk Monitoring Reports for Special Education Finance are due to DESE by January 31, 2020.
- All follow up data for the October Title I Monitoring has been submitted to DESE as of January 10th.
- Preschool/Kindergarten Screening has been scheduled for March 6, 2020.
- We have had 14 referrals for special education services. Four students have qualified for services, seven have not qualified and three are in the testing process.
- We currently have 75 students with IEP's enrolled in the districts in grades preschool through 12th grade. We are serving 11 students through Speech Intervening Services.

Curriculum and Grant Writing

- Teachers spent part of the afternoon of the PD day working on their curriculum writing.
- The Curriculum Winter Symposium will be held February 23-25 at The Lodge at Old Kinderhook.
- Currently working with several teachers and staff on grant opportunities for the district Chemistry, School Safety and CTE/Business Program
