## **Federal Programs**

- > Special Education staff members are currently finishing up the fall testing for our students participating in the DLM Testing. We have three students taking the alternate assessment this year. Another testing window open in February.
- > Title I and Special Education Monitoring process is continuing. We are starting to input files for the special education portion of the review.
- > We have had 12 referrals for special education services. Two students have qualified for services, six have not qualified and four are in the testing process.
- ➤ We currently have 66 students with IEP's enrolled in the districts in grades preschool through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. We are serving 11 students through Speech Intervening Services.

## **Curriculum and Grant Writing**

- ➤ A curriculum work day was held after school on Monday November 18<sup>th</sup> for all teachers writing curriculum
- ➤ Northeast Missouri Curriculum Directors meeting will be Wednesday November 20<sup>th</sup>.
- Currently working with several teachers and staff on grant opportunities for the district. Grants involve STEM, Chemistry, School Safety and After School Meals.
