## **Federal Programs**

> Special Education staff members are currently participating in the DLM Testing. We have 3 students taking the alternate assessment this year.

- ➤ We have had 4 referrals for special education services. One student has qualified for services, and three is in the testing process.
- ➤ We currently have 65 students with IEP's enrolled in the districts in grades preschool through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. We are serving 9 students through Speech Intervening Services.
- > All records for the October monitoring for ESEA have been submitted. Next cycle is due in December.

## Curriculum

- Supercore has begun writing curriculum and using the new forms and process. We are meet on PD days for work time as well as anytime before or after school that teachers want additional assistance.
- > All curriculum binders with standards are available for teachers to pick up at any time. Also, curriculum drives on Google have been shared with all teachers.
