Academic Letters

With consultation from the Student council, beginning in 1990-91 the Board of Education established the following guidelines for academic letters for Knox County High School students in grades 9 through 12.

A student currently enrolled in grades 10, 11 or 12 who meets these qualifications, will receive a varsity academic letter:

The student must have earned at least an 8.0 grade point average (on a 11.0 scale) in three of the four quarters immediately preceding the awarding of the letters in the first quarter of the next school year.

These student will also receive either a gold or silver bar, under these guidelines:

Students who placed on the A honor roll at least two quarters will receive a gold bar. Those who placed on the B honor will receive a silver bar.

A student in grades 10, 11 or 12 who has at least an 8.0 grade point average (on an 11.0 scale) in at least three of the last four immediately preceding quarters, and who has not received a letter, will have earned the letter. The student will also receive the appropriate bar.

A student in grade 9 who has earned at least an 8.0 (on an 11.0 scale) in the first three quarters of that school year will have earned the letter. The student will also receive the appropriate bar.

Students already possessing a letter will receive the appropriate bar.
