Student Academic Achievement

Graduation Exercises

Because the Board believes that completion of the requirements for a diploma from Knox County R-I High School District is an achievement that improves the community as well as the individual, the Board wishes to recognize in a publicly celebrated graduation exercise.

Accordingly, appropriate graduation programs may be planned by the high school, under the direction of the high school principal, on the date selected by the Board of Education.

Only students who have successfully completed the graduation requirements for a high school diploma and are in good standing may participate in graduation exercises.

Students who elect to graduate early will not participate in spring graduation ceremonies in accordance with Policy and Regulation 2540.
