## **Policy 2611** **(Regulation 2611)**

### **Discipline**

#### **Bomb Threats**

In the event that a phone call or other notice is received which indicates that a bomb has been placed in a school building, on the school grounds or on a school-owned vehicle, the district administrative staff shall have effective emergency procedures which can be implemented on short notice ensuring optimum safety for students and school personnel. The procedures established in cooperation with the fire department and law enforcement officials will be followed by principals, professionals and support staff members. These security measures have been reviewed and approved by the Board. Most of the details are classified information.

The safety of students is the prime consideration in the procedures authorized for use. The senior law enforcement officer present and the building principal or designated school official will determine the appropriate procedures to follow.
