Student Welfare

Use of Tracking Devices

Except as otherwise explicitly authorized by the Board of Education, District employees are prohibited from requiring students to use an identification device that uses radio frequency identification technology, or related technology to identify the student, to transmit information regarding the student, or to monitor or trace the location of the student. A Board vote to adopt a specific security system that employs the type of identification device described in this paragraph shall be sufficient to establish the authorization required under this policy. Such authorization shall apply solely and exclusively to the specific security system adopted by the Board, and shall not be applicable to any other devices or systems that have not been approved by vote of the Board.
