RE: Administrator's Report

Federal Programs

- Special Education staff members are starting the DLM Testing. We have 1 student taking the alternate assessment this year.
- We have had 5 referrals for special education services. Two students have qualified for services, and three are in the testing process.
- We currently have 76 students with IEP's enrolled in the districts in grades preschool through 12th grade. We are serving 15 students through Speech Intervening Services and 5 students on 504 plan.

Grants

- Researching the EARLY CHILDHOOD grants which can be used to expand our preschool program into birth-3.
- Continue to work on and finalize all things for the USDA grant for electric buses.
- We are beginning to work on the Teacher Retention and Grow your Own Grant opportunities through DESE.

Curriculum

- Monthly curriculum meetings, for teachers writing curriculum this year, are being offered Wednesday and Thursday this week. These meetings allow for collaboration among the staff and support from the curriculum director in the writing process.
