

Student Activities

Current Seasons

- Varsity football's season continues as of this reporting date.
- JH basketball seasons are in full swing, and we are managing to play an A/B schedule for both boys and girls.
- Varsity basketball practice is underway for both boys and girls.

Equipment or Facilities

- The baseball backstop remodel is well underway. The concrete access work is complete. The contractor has set the steel poles to support the net backstop.
- Our Hudl Focus camera is installed at the football field, and operational.
- We set a concrete pad and Mr. Green's class will be building a storage shed for softball to keep some of their larger equipment and supplies.
- We have hired a contractor to improve the electrical support to the football press box as part of a remodeling effort.
- We have been approached by a disc golf company with a proposal to build a 9-hole course with a bottom line of \$5,380. This course would be for PE classes and open to the public outside of school and outdoor event hours.

COVID-19 Guidance

- Current CDC guidance for schools is the same as last fall: Masking, Distancing, Hand washing, Cleaning, Contact Tracing
- We will continue with hand washing and cleaning. We recommend masking and distancing for unvaccinated children and adults.
- **We are contact tracing for all close contacts in the "in-school" environment, using seating records and teacher interviews. We are not contact tracing on PE, recess, or sports-only environments. We provide names to the KCHD and they determine quarantine requirements based on vaccination status and history of disease.**
- In an October 8th release, DHHS and DESE released new information that provide a "Test to Stay" option. This option would allow those who would have been quarantined previously to stay in school if they agree to test periodically and remain masked.
- There is potential funding for an individual to manage COVID-related responsibilities, from Test to Stay testing to return to school dates.
- **We reached a peak of 132 students isolated and quarantined on/about November 8th, with approximately 30 positive cases. Most confirmed cases were in the elementary school.**
