Federal Programs

- ➤ Preschool and Kindergarten screening is almost complete. We will continue to take appointments for as long as necessary.
- ➤ Planning and needs assessments for next year will be taking place in May and June.
- ➤ We have had 15 referrals for special education services. 5 students have qualified for services, 5 was not eligible and 5 are in the testing/eligibility process.
- ➤ We currently have 76 students with IEP's enrolled in the district preschool through 12th grade. We are serving 15 students through Speech Intervening Services.
- ➤ MAP-A testing is complete.

<u>Grants</u>

➤ I attended a grant workshop in St. Louis. We are looking at forming a grant team for the district. New information will be shared with teachers as it becomes available.

Curriculum

- ➤ Math and ELA teachers are finishing up their curriculum. Those will be approved as they are completed.
- ➤ Science and Social Studies will be writing curriculum during the 22-23 school year.
