Title I

➤ Preschool screenings are completed and we are looking at the numbers. We project 2 full classes of 4-year-olds and 2 half day classes of 3-year-olds. Final letters will be sent out in June. Our incoming kindergarten class is projected to have 35-40 students.

Special Education

- ➤ Teachers are completing end of year paperwork and updating IEP's. I expect several form changes again over the summer to the IEP and other special education documents and forms.
- We have had 15 referrals for special education services. 8 students have qualified for services, 6 were not eligible and 1 the parent did not complete the referral paperwork.
- ➤ We currently have 81 students with IEP's enrolled in the district preschool through 12th grade. We are serving 14 students through Speech Intervening Services.

Curriculum writing for the year is almost complete.
