RE: Administrator's Report

Title I

- Preschool screenings are completed and we are looking at the numbers. We project 2 full classes of 4-year-olds and 2 half day classes of 3-year-olds. Final letters will be sent out in June. Our incoming kindergarten class is projected to have 35-40 students.

Special Education

- Teachers are completing end of year paperwork and updating IEP's. I expect several form changes again over the summer to the IEP and other special education documents and forms.
- We have had 15 referrals for special education services. 8 students have qualified for services, 6 were not eligible and 1 the parent did not complete the referral paperwork.
- We currently have 81 students with IEP's enrolled in the district preschool through 12th grade. We are serving 14 students through Speech Intervening Services.

Grants

- We are currently working on several grant for the district
 - EPA Clean Bus Project Grant

Curriculum

- Curriculum writing for the year is almost complete. Next school year social studies and science will be writing curriculum along with any new teachers during the 21-22 school year who may need to write theirs for ELA and Math. That should complete the writing rotation and updates and revisions will be ongoing.
