Federal Programs

- I will be attending the Special Education Conference September 25th-27th
- MAP-A assessment will be administered to 1 student this year. They are taking fall and spring assessments.
- The district will be participating in Federal Monitoring for Title Programs this year. The first submission is due October 15th. It is also the monitoring year for Special Education.
- We currently have 33 full day preschool students and 22 half day preschool student enrolled
- We have had four referrals for special education services and. All students are in the data review and testing process.
- We currently have 80 students with IEP's enrolled in the district in grades preschool through 12th grade and are serving 7 students through speech intervening services and 8 students with 504 plans

Curriculum

- Regional Curriculum meetings September 19th with area curriculum directors meeting following the regional meeting.
- Science and Social Studies will be writing curriculum this year as well as middle school ELA.

Grants

- Anna Van Delft has received a Dollar General Literacy Grant for the district to be used for the elementary library.
