RE: Administrator's Report

Federal Programs

- We have had 8 referrals for special education services. Two students have been tested and we are waiting on results, four have their testing scheduled and 2 in in the data collection process.
- The October Tiered Monitoring for Title programs has been submitted. The monitoring occurs every three years with submissions due in October, December and February.
- We currently have 80 students with IEP's enrolled in the districts in grades preschool through 12th grade. We are serving 15 students through Speech Intervening Services and 6 students on 504 plans.

Grants

- We have submitted a grant to the Office of Early Childhood to help offset some of the costs of expanding out preschool programs.
- We are looking into a grant to provide hydroponic stations for elementary classes to utilize.

Curriculum

- Monthly curriculum meetings, for teachers writing curriculum this year, continue to be offered monthly. These meetings allow for collaboration among the staff and support from the curriculum director in the writing process.
