RE: Administrator's Report

Federal Programs

- The next round of Tier Monitoring for Federal Programs is due December 15th. Monitoring for special education is also ongoing and we are gathering files to submit to DESE in January.
- Preschool and Kindergarten Screening is going back to in person one day screening event this year. It will be held in March. Planning and organizing is starting to take place.
- We have had 10 referrals for special education services. Two students have qualified for services, 3 did not qualify and 3 are in the testing process and 2 the parents requested not to proceed with the referral and testing.
- We currently have 81 students with IEP's enrolled in the districts in grades preschool through 12th grade. We are serving 11 students through Speech Intervening Services.
- We currently have 8 students on 504 plans and one referral.

Curriculum and Grant Writing

- The district has received word that we have received a Hydroponics STEM Program grant for the elementary.
- The district has received a grant for our preschool expansion grant from DESE to help offset some of the costs of our new preschool classroom.
- Curriculum work is ongoing. Monthly workdays are being offered to teachers working on curriculum writing in ELA and Math as well as one-on-one work meetings as requested.
