RE: Administrator's Report

Federal Programs

- Special Education File Review has. The district will submit 10 files for review. We have input some of the required files and will finish those in January.
- Tiered Monitoring is ongoing. Our next submission is due in February. We are now receiving feedback from our October Monitoring Submission.
- We have had 12 referrals for special education services. Two students have qualified for services, Five did not qualify Three are in the testing and data review process and two the parents requested not to proceed with testing.
- December 1 Child Count Report has been completed and submitted to DESE.
- We currently have 84 students with IEP's enrolled in the districts in grades preschool through 12th grade. We are serving 15 students through Speech Intervening Services and 15 students receiving speech or language as a related service.
- Planning for Pre-School and Kindergarten Screening has begun. We are going back to in-person mass screening which will be held in March.
- We have 8 students on 504 Plans and 1 referral in process.

Curriculum and Grant Writing

- Curriculum writing is ongoing. No work days were help this month but will resume in January.
