Federal Programs

- Preschool and Kindergarten screening is complete. Letters will be going out to families in the next week regarding preschool for the 2023-2024 school year.
- April monitoring review is complete. This is the final monitoring for Federal Programs for the year.
- All Special Education files requested for monitoring have been submitted.
- We have had 16 referrals for special education services. 8 students have qualified for services, 8 was not eligible.
- We currently have 83 students with IEP's enrolled in the district preschool through 12th grade. We are serving 18 students through Speech Intervening Services.

Grants

- We are currently waiting to hear back on the DESE Safety Grant, GENYOUth Grant for kitchen drink cooler and a playground grant.
- We received the DESE Immediate Responsive Service Grant to help provide mental health services over the summer to our students in need.
- I am working on the COPS School Violence Prevention Program Grant

Curriculum

- Science and Social Studies teachers are finishing up their curriculum. Those are due and will be approved in May.
