Federal Programs

- The Corrective Action Plan and documentation for our special education monitoring has been submitted and approved.
- > We have had 14 referrals for special education services. Two students have qualified for services, three did not qualify and nine are in the testing process.
- We currently have 75 students with IEP's enrolled in the districts in grades preschool through 12th grade. We are serving 11 students through Speech Intervening Services.
- > We currently have 6 students on 504 plans and one referral.

Curriculum and Grant Writing

- The district has received word that did not receive the COPS School Violence Prevention Program Grant
- The district has applied for additional grant funding through the Missouri Quality Pre-K Program Grant.
- The district will be gathering data to apply for the Stronger Connections Grant. This grant is due in January.
- Curriculum work is ongoing. Monthly workdays are being offered to teachers working on curriculum writing, as well as one-on-one work meetings as requested.
