RE: Administrator’s Report

Federal Programs

- We have had 13 referrals for special education services. 5 students have been tested and we are waiting on results, three have their testing scheduled and 5 in the data collection process.
- We have had two referral for a 504 evaluation. One student has qualified and the other is in the evaluation process.
- We currently have 72 students with IEP’s enrolled in the districts in grades preschool through 12th grade. We are serving 15 students through Speech Intervening Services and 7 students on 504 plans.

Grants

- Exploring DNR Grant Opportunities to help with energy projects
- Assisting Tracy Hamlin with a NRA grant for the FFA trap team.

Curriculum

- October 14th PD is focused on core curriculum alignment and supervised by our Step-Up Curriculum Consultant, Sarah Rayl.
- Super Core is updating their curriculum for any changes and working on adding the assessment piece.
