## **Federal Programs**

- We have had 22 referrals for special education services. Four students have qualified for an IEP, three students qualified for a 504 plan, three students did not qualify and twelve students are in the testing process.
- We currently have 76 students with IEP's enrolled in the districts in grades preschool through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. We are serving 11 students through Speech Intervening Services.
- We currently have 10 students on 504 plans and one referral.
- The December 1 Child Count has been completed and submitted to DESE.
- Parents as Teachers will be hosting a Christmas Party December 19<sup>th</sup> at 6:00PM for all PAT families and anyone interested in PAT.
- Civil Rights data collection opened December 9<sup>th</sup> and must be completed by March 7<sup>th</sup>.

## **Curriculum and Grant Writing**

- Curriculum work is ongoing. Our January PD will include a Step-Up Consulting who will be working with our core teachers and their curriculum assignment and assessments.
- The district continues to wait to hear on the NRA grant to help our FFA Trap Team.
