RE: Administrator's Report

Federal Programs

- We have had 32 referrals for special education services. 10 students have qualified for services, 6 were eligible for a 504, 12 were not eligible and 4 are in the testing process.
- We currently have 76 students with IEP's enrolled in the district preschool through 12th grade. We are serving 12 students through Speech Intervening Services. We have 11 students on 504 plans.
- Title I program surveys were distributed at parent teacher conferences. The annual Title I meeting will take place before mid-June.
- Parents as Teacher had a successful Group Connections in collaboration with FFA. 21 families and 37 children attended the event.

Grants

- The NRA grant was not fully funded as initially thought. The grant funded the shooting goggles/glasses, but not the ammunition and targets.
- DESE put out this week that the ESSER data collection has been suspended and is not required this year.
- We are finalizing out data and wrapping up yearly grants through DESE. These include the Post-Secondary Advising, CTE Base and Performance, Feminine Hygiene, Career Ladder, and Grow your Own

Curriculum

- We will approve super-core curriculum updates in May.
