Changes made in the last two years:

- Purchase of our six 100% electric buses for a total cost of \$99,000
- Purchased 3 new Diesel buses for trips.
- Seven of the new buses have air conditioning on them.
- Ordered updated Transportant system.

- District is now fully certified as a bus driver training site for ELDT.
- We have bus monitors on 8 of our 10 routes
- New break room for the bus drivers
